As the children of Israel entered into the land of Canaan, their first great victory came about as they brought down the walls of Jericho through seven days of public worship. (Joshua 6)

When Jehoshaphat, King of Jerusalem, was confronted with the fact that, "a great multitude is coming against you from beyond the sea from Syria'. He then consulted God who commanded him to send out, "those who should sing to the Lord, and who should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went our before the army". The enemy was defeated and a great victory won.

When Paul and Silas were imprisoned at Phillipi in the worst part if the prison "At midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. A great earthquake freed them resulting in the salvation of the jailor and his family". (Acts 16).
